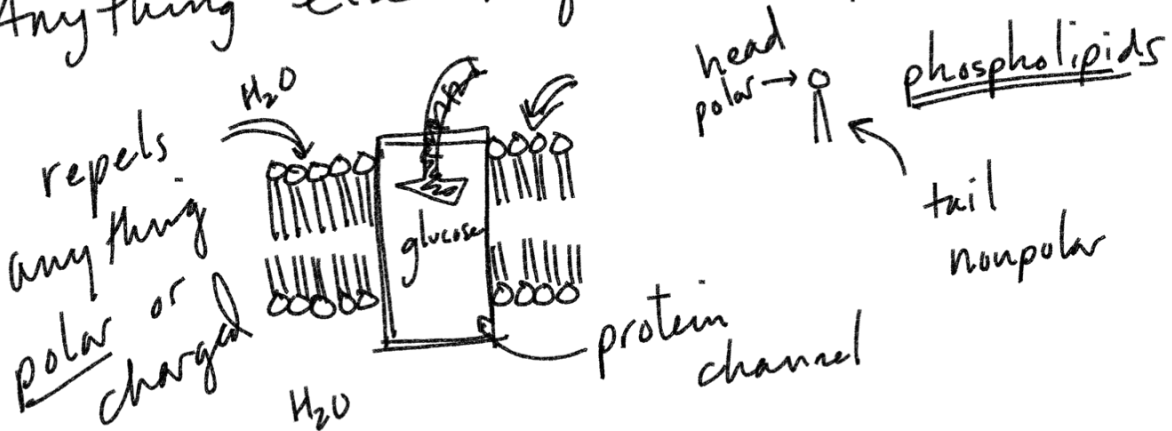
Membranes are selectively permeable  
allow the passage of some - but not all -  
compounds

Membrane is nonpolar - composed of lipids

Membrane allows passage of :  
don't need a protein { - nonpolar compounds  
- very small particles



Anything else requires a protein channels



Carbohydrates allows extend outward  
facing the extracellular environment  
on the plasma membrane.
